2014 MSJC Graduate Survey Recap

<u>Background:</u> Students responded to a self-administered online graduate survey. The survey was completed by 172 students.

Results:

General:

- 95% of respondents attended either MVC or SJC.
- 94% of respondents received an AA/AS
- 78% of respondents are planning on transferring to a 4-year institution
- 13% of respondents were able to secure a job with their degree.
- 76% of respondents' parents do not hold a 4-year degree.

Student Services:

- 94% of respondents utilized counseling
 - o 89% found it helpful
 - o 91% say it was important to their success
- 79% of respondents utilized financial aid
 - o 76% found it helpful
 - o 81% say it was important to their success
- 69% of respondents utilized tutoring or SI
 - o 68% found it helpful
 - o 70% say it was important to their success
- 63% of respondents utilized Eagle Access Center
 - o 65% found it helpful
 - o 58% say it was important to their success
- 49% of respondents utilized Career/Transfer Center
 - o 50% found it helpful
 - o 53% say it was important to their success

Satisfaction:

- 90% felt they were provided with basic, general, and career skills.
- 79% felt they were empowered with skills to affect positive change.
 - o 17% had no opinion
- 90% say they have improved communication skills
- 90% felt they were more effective critical thinking skills
- 76% were more aesthetically aware of their surroundings
 - o 16% had no opinion
- 87% felt more socially aware
- 88% were more responsible
- 75% felt scientifically aware
- 97% of respondents claim they were either "Satisfied", or "Very Satisfied" with their overall experience at MSJC
