MSJC peaked during the 10-11 academic year with transfer students. There were a total of 1,094 transfers with 517 going to CSU schools and 130 going to UC schools. 10-11 saw a 53% increase in CSU & UC transfers over academic year 09-10. Since 10-11, MSJC has been trending down with student transfers:

- AY11-12: MSJC transfers have decreased by 13% from AY10-11.
 - o UC & CSU transfers decreased 19% from AY10-11.
 - o ISP & OOS transfers decreased 5% from AY10-11.
- AY12-13: MSJC transfers have decreased by 7% from AY 11-12.
 - o UC & CSU transfers decreased 8% from AY 11-12.
 - o ISP & OOS transfers decreased 5% from AY 11-12.
