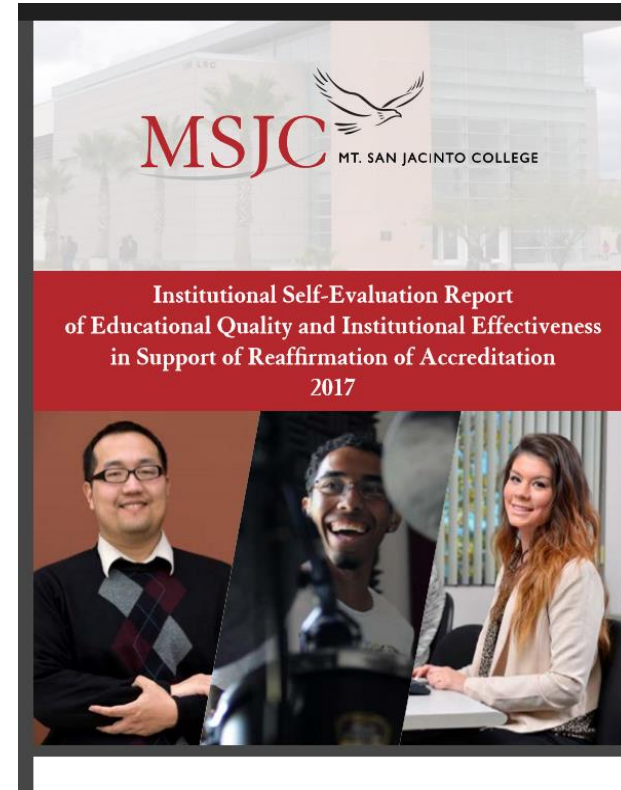

- 12 Site Visit Team Members - Chair, Members, & ACCJC Vice President
- Interviews and Verification of ISER Evidence and Content
- Opening Reception (Monday), (2) Open Sessions, Site Visits to all Locations
- Development of External Evaluation Team Report Draft and Recommendations
- Report-Out and Get Out!

What is Your Role During the Site Visit?

- Stay Calm!
- Be Available and Accessible for Potential Interviews
- If Interviewed...
 - Be on time to the interview
 - Answer what you know...if you don't know, simply say so!
 - Provide any additional information requested in a timely manner
- If Contacted for Additional Information or Evidence...
 - Respond to requests quickly

- Review the Collection of Evidence for Your Accreditation Standard
- Enroll in the Canvas Accreditation 101 Course
