Adult Education

FREE English as a Second Language (ESL), Citizenship (CITZ), High School Education Classes (GED), and Introduction to Career Classes

English as a Second Language (ESL)

Our ESL classes help you develop listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills that pertain to life and work in the United States.

Adult Basic Education (ABE)

Our ABE classes prepare you for basic mathematics, reading, and writing to prepare you for GED level classes.

General Education Development (GED)

Our GED classes prepare you to take the GED or HiSET exam that, when passed, offers a high school equivalency certificate.

Citizenship (CITZ)

Citizenship classes prepare immigrants for the naturalization process and the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services interview. You will learn U.S. government and history and practice reading and speaking skills necessary to pass the test.

Introduction to Career Classes

Introduction to Career Classes are non-credit classes that help prepare you to jumpstart your career or re-enter the workforce. Students will learn new skills within these career pathways which lead to employment opportunities. These introductory career courses also support students wishing to continue their education within certificate or degree programs at Mt. San Jacinto College.

Non-Credit Counseling Services

All Adult Education classes include academic and career counseling. If you are interested in continuing your education, taking career training courses, or seeking employment opportunities, you will have access to counseling services during scheduled classes throughout your semester.

Multi-Level 1 (Beginning/Intermediate)

Beginning ⇒	Intermediate ⇒	Advanced 1 ⇒	Advanced ⇒ 2
In this level students will learn basic reading, writing, listening and speaking skills for everyday needs. Instruction will emphasize general language construction.	In this level, students will continue to practice reading, writing, listening, and speaking skills. Students will improve conversational skills and learn more about verb tenses.	This level emphasizes development of advanced reading, writing, listening, and speaking skills for work and study.	This level has two separate skilled-based classes for students to further develop their English skills in the classroom and work environment. In this class the focus is practicing listening and speaking. In the other class, the focus is practicing reading and writing. Placement evaluations are required for this level and administered by the teacher.

Each student will be evaluated at the beginning of the semester.

GED Classes

ABE / GED Classes

Students will learn writing, reading comprehension, science, social studies, arithmetic, pre-algebra, algebra, and geometry skills required to pass the GED or HiSET test.

Most classes are multi-level and multi-subject. ABE courses are pre-GED courses which focus on skill building in mathematics, reading, and writing. GED courses are multi-subject and cover the full battery of subjects needed to pass the GED/HiSET test. GED Focus in math and English courses specifically focus on these subject areas for students needing in depth instruction within these subject areas.

Students who are currently taking or have finished our GED / HiSET classes can take the actual test at home on their computer or in-person at an accredited testing center.

GED/HiSET Test Vouchers Available!

Vouchers are available to support students with cost of testing based on student need, readiness, and progress per instructors' recommendation.

IMPORTANT ADULT EDUCATION PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Mandatory Orientation

After registration, all students will participate in a **mandatory orientation** during the first week of class to learn about our procedures and requirements to ensure student success in our program.

Test Requirements for ESL, GED, and Citizenship classes

- All registered adult education students at MSJC must take a required CASAS pre-test at the beginning of the semester and a CASAS post-test at the end of semester to measure student progress within their program.
- Students that do not complete the required testing will be dropped from the program.

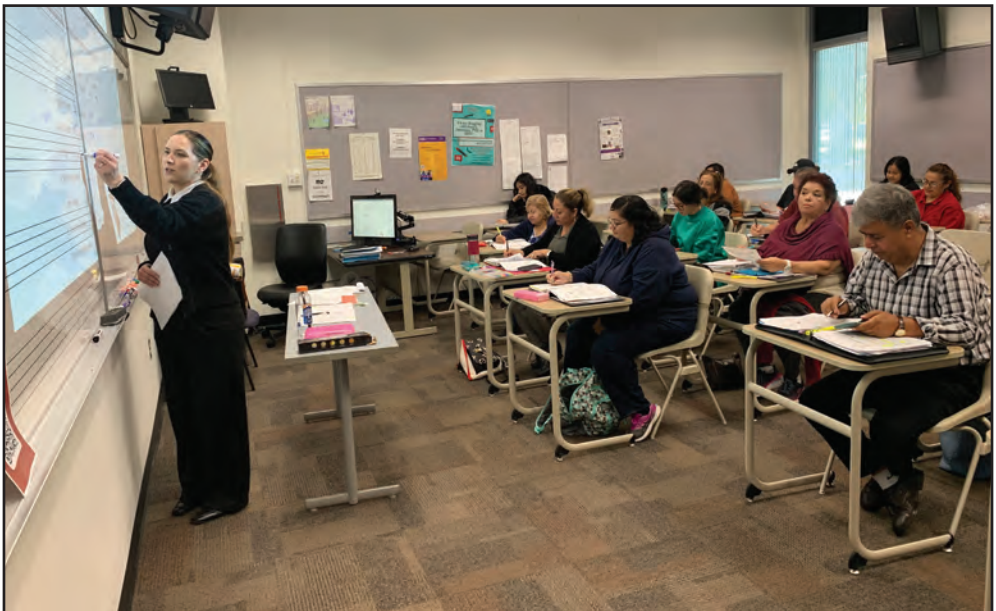

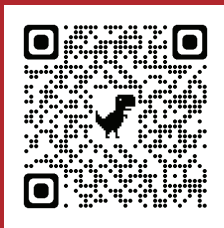
