

Watercolor Supply List

- 1) Reds : Alizarin Crimson, Cadmium Red
- 2) Blues: Cobalt Blue, Cerulian Blue, Ultramarine Blue
- 3) Browns: Burnt Umber, Burnt Sienna
- 4) Green: Sap Green
- 5) Yellow: Lemon, Azo Yellow, Cadmium Yellow (any one of these).

Brushes:

1" flat ½" flat #12 round #3 or #4 round

Supplies:

Palette or a plastic plate

Jar for Water
#4H pencil
Eraser
Kleenex
Rag to Wipe Brushes
Sponge
Salt
Masking Liquid
Masking Tape
Plywood or heavy cardboard to mount paper (12" x 16")

Instructor uses 260 lb. single elephant paper - Arche's Cold Pressed Watercolor paper – 25 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 40" (Students can do 8 paintings on one sheet). Instructor can give you a sheet each for \$10.00 or 1/8 sheet for \$1.25. Instructor purchases material from Cheap Joe's 1-800-227-2788
