New Classes Coming Fall Semester 2018!

MSJC Adult Ed will be offering new career preparation classes for Fall Semester 2018 in Automotive, Construction, Business, Child Development, and College, Career and Life Planning.

- Light Duty Automotive Service Technology (SJC) will teach basic repair and maintenance skills for trucks and cars.
- Construction (MVC) will teach basic construction skills, language, and safety. Students will gain skills to start a career in construction and the building trades.
- Introduction to Business Administration will teach basic skills in business, math, customer service, sales, and professionalism.
- Introduction to Child Development will teach basic skills in working with children, appropriate lessons and activities, ensuring children's safety, and exploring jobs in child care.
- Get Focused Stay Focused (THEC -Temecula Higher Education Campus) will teach college, career, and life planning. Students will learn about themselves and their values, along with researching careers and what it takes to do a variety of jobs.

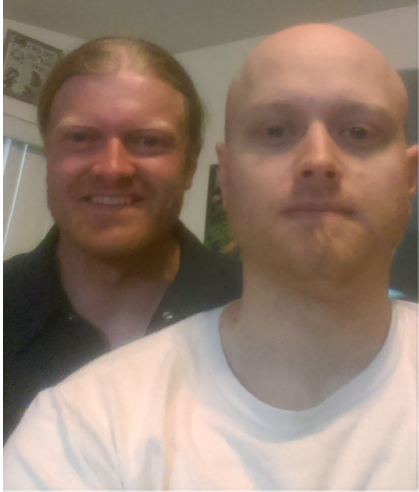


Recognition Ceremony For GED Graduates

MSJC Adult Ed hosted its first GED recognition ceremony Friday, May 18 at the Menifee Valley Campus.

MSJC's Adult Education Program Class of 2018 had the largest number of students to obtain a GED. More than 80 students, ages 18 to 65, are projected completed their GED this year. More than 25 of those students have transitioned into career certificate or associate degree programs. "Earning a GED is a major achievement for our students," Amy Campbell, MSJC Director of Adult Education says. "This is a major milestone in each of our graduates' lives and they deserve this important celebration."

MSJC offers high school equivalency (HSE) courses that prepare students to take the GED. The classes are free and are offered at the San Jacinto Campus, Menifee Valley Campus and the Temecula Higher Education Center. In fall and spring semesters, MSJC also partners with Perris Adult School and offers classes at the Perris Adult School and Perris High School.
