

STUDENT WORKFORCE PROGRAM

ELIGIBILITY

SWP employees must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Be a U.S. Citizen, a U.S. National, Permanent U.S. Resident or on a student visa F1/F2
- Maintain at least half-time enrollment status (6+ units) for each Fall and Spring semester employed
 - For Summer, must be enrolled in at least 3+ units or have intent to register for the Fall semester
- Maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA each term of employment
- At the time of hire, students under 18 years of age must present a high school diploma or GED

San Jacinto College offers a wonderful opportunity for students to learn about working for the district on a temporary, at-will basis while progressing towards their educational goals through the Student Workforce Program (SWP). The goal of SWP is intended to provide a balance between the interests of the student and the needs of the department. We accept SWP applications for a variety of temporary, part-time, and entry-level jobs throughout the academic year.
