Primary physical building revisions: Modifications will be made to the public entry areas to provide secure, enclosed lobbies. Visitors will have to check in with the reception staff who will be located behind a metal-framed high-strength glass partition wall with a small pass-through window. Entry beyond the secure lobby will not be allowed until after they have been cleared by staff and "buzzed in" past a new secure entry door.

Primary security equipment installations: The main entry doors and all other exterior doors will be fitted with high-tech card readers with access-control lock mechanisms that will be tied into the District's secure access control system. All exterior entry points and building perimeters will be monitored by high-tech security cameras that can be monitored by CDEC staff and security personnel.
