Information on Application: Verify that all information entered into the application is complete and precise. Use your personal email for communication unless you are an MSJC Student then use your MSJC student email address.
TEAS Results: Print out a copy of your TEAS results and submit with application. If you have taken the TEAS more than once please print out a copy of the full report of all TEAS attempts.
Contact ATI directly at www.atitesting.com to request a copy/transcript of your TEAS score to be sent directly to the MSJC ADN program.
Once your transcript from ATI has been sent, email MursingandAH@msjc.edu to verify that official scores were sent to the Nursing Department. As a reminder we take your 1st passing score of 62% or higher.
Copy of Nursing Evaluation: Provide copy of the Nursing Evaluation Eligibility – "Program Notes," that state your GPA, general ed. completion, language, etc. The Program Notes can be found in MSJC Self Service → Student planning → View My Progress → then select Program Notes for "Nursing Non-transfer RN" degree.
If you did not submit a nursing evaluation request, you are unable to apply to the program at this time.
Current Licenses and/or Certificate: Please provide a copy of any current Licenses and/or Certificates that you may have. If you are an LVN, please print out a copy of your license from the Breeze website and submit with application.
Diplomas or Degrees: If your evaluation does not include your diploma or degree, attach a copy with your application.
