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This one-semester course provides the student with the knowledge and skills to care for the ill or injured person in the pre-hospital setting. This course is taken to help the student prepare for working with fire service or ambulance service. Successful completion of this course qualifies the student to sit for the National Registry certification exam which is a required certification for Fire Service or Ambulance service work. Hospital clinical, ambulance and/or squad ride-along is required.

EMS acceptance will be distributed to the first 32 students who complete the required forms.

The Nursing & Allied Health Department will be the **ONLY** department to distribute the instructor consent forms

Application will be available **October 3rd** for the Spring Semester.
