

# Board Policy – 5210 Communicable Disease

- The Mt. San Jacinto Community College District is committed to providing a safe and healthy learning environment. The Superintendent/President shall establish procedures necessary to ensure cooperation with local public health officials in measures necessary for the prevention and control of communicable diseases in students. Administrative procedures regarding COVID-19 will include vaccination and testing measures to mitigate the risks surrounding exposure to COVID-19

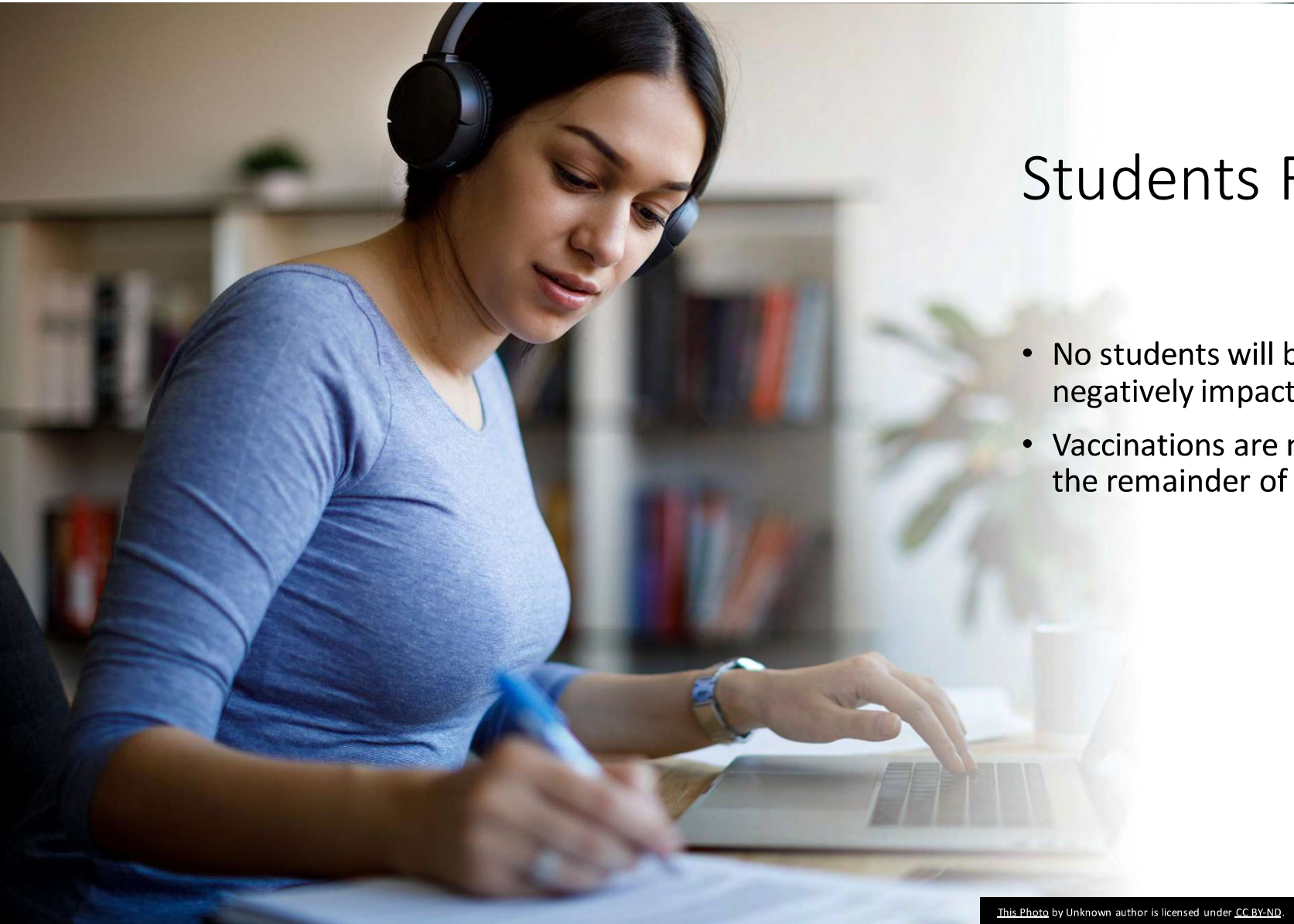

All students Eligible

- Face to face
- Hybrid
- Fully Online
- Currently Enrolled or New Students



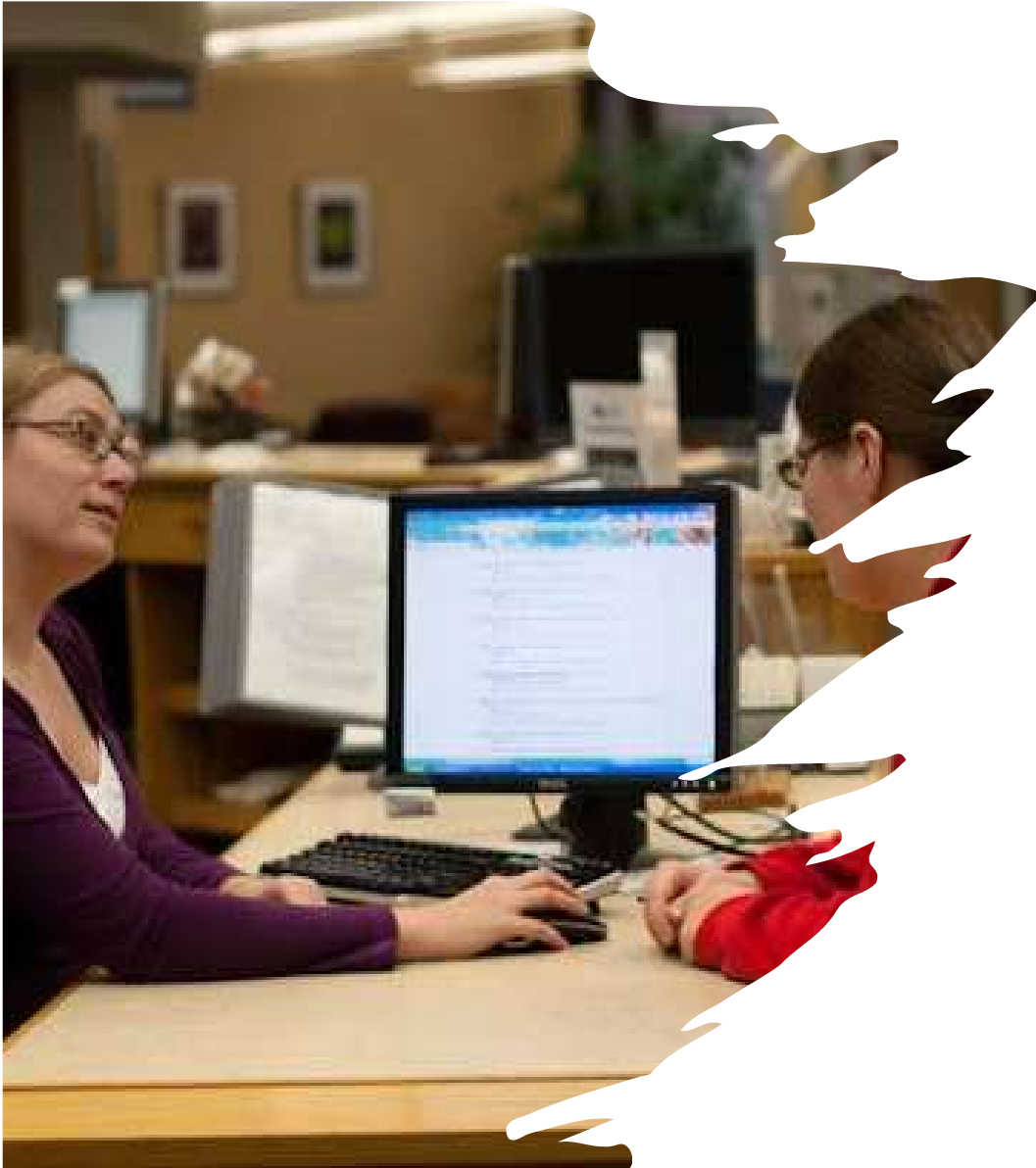

## If Students Want to Register for FTF/Hybrid Courses...

Registration Holds for all FTF/Hybrid Courses

Vaccination Clearance Required Prior to Registration

- Students must upload vaccination card to Cleared4
- Exemptions (Medical/Religious)
- Registration holds released within ~24 hours

Students May Register Once Holds Released

## If Students Want to Register for Online Courses...

---

Registration Open for All Online Courses

Vaccination NOT Required

Registration Appointments NOT Impacted





If Students Want to Register for **BOTH** FTF/Hybrid and Online Courses...

Registration Holds for FTF/Hybrid Courses Only

Vaccination Clearance Required Prior to Registration for FTF/Hybrid Only

- Students must upload vaccination card to Cleared4
- Exemptions (Medical/Religious)
- Registration holds released within ~24 hours

Students May Register for Online Courses Without Vaccination Clearance





## If Students Enroll in Online Courses but Seek In-Person Services

Library, LRC, Tutoring, Counseling, etc. (More than 15 minute interaction)

Vaccination Clearance Required Prior to Seeking In-Person Service

- Students must upload vaccination card to Cleared4
- Exemptions (Medical/Religious)

Cleared4 Daily COVID-19 Check In

Mandatory Face Coverings

# Exemption Clearances

- Medical or Religious Exemptions
- Submit Electronic Exemption Statements via Onbase (link to come!)
  - Upload Release from Medical Provider
- No Documents will be Accepted In-Person
- Approvals/Denials Processed within ~ 7-10 Days
- If Approved Registration Holds for FTF/Hybrid will be Released



---

## Students Approved for Exemption

---

- Weekly COVID-19 Testing Required
- Daily COVID-19 Check In
- Mandatory Face Coverings
- Progressive Discipline for Missed Tests
