

Jan 6	RTA "GoPass" bus ridership for Spring 2016 begins for eligible (registered) students
Jan 13	"Same Day Pay" begins – Payment for all fees is due at the time of registration. Prior to this date, fees are due within four days of registration (including holidays and weekends)
Jan 18	College Closed (Martin Luther King Jr. Day)
Jan 20	Regular instruction begins
Jan 25 – 29	Audit Forms accepted

Due to the wide variety of start and end dates of classes, it is not possible to list all of the dates for every class in the schedule publication. You may request a registration statement from Enrollment Services for specific dates, including refund date, drop without a "W" date and drop with a "W" date. The last day to drop a class with a refund is 10% of the class. For short-term classes, this is typically before the second class meeting. In some cases, however, it is prior to the first class meeting.

Mt. San Jacinto Community College Student Right-to-Know Rates for Fall 2011 Cohort

Completion Rate: 23.79 % Transfer Rate: 16.01 %

In compliance with the Student-Right-to-Know and Campus Security Act of 1990 (Public Law 101-542), it is the policy of our college district to make available its completion and transfer rates to all current and prospective students. Beginning in Fall 2011, a cohort of all certificate-, degree-, and transfer-seeking first-time, full-time students were tracked over a three-year period. Their completion and transfer rates are listed above. These rates do not represent the success rates of the entire student population at the College nor do they account for student outcomes occurring after this three-year tracking period.

Based upon the cohort defined above, a Completer is a student who attained a certificate or degree or became 'transfer prepared' during a three-year period, from Fall 2011 to Spring 2014. Students who have completed 60 transferable units with a GPA of 2.0 or better are considered 'transfer-prepared'. Students who transferred to another post-secondary institution, prior to attaining a degree, certificate, or becoming 'transfer-prepared' during a five-semester period, from Spring 2012 to Spring 2014, are transfer students.

Form 1098-T. In compliance with IRS regulations, MSJC reports information about student tuition paid in excess of scholarships and waivers during the calendar year. To be eligible to receive a 1098-T, students must have made eligible tuition payments and have a valid SSN on record with the college.
