



2022-23 DoD Cyber Scholarship Program (CySP)

As an NSA/DHS Center of Academic Excellence, National University students are eligible to apply for the DoD CySP. Students outside of cybersecurity in technical fields and students transferring from community colleges into our BS CYB program are also eligible to apply. Community College students or new MS CYB would need to be accepted at NU by Feb 1st and start classes in Fall 2022. The DoD estimates awarding scholarships beginning with the Fall 2022 semester.

Students selected as Cyber Scholars will receive:

- **FULL COST** of tuition
- **FULL COST** of required books and tech fees
- **Up to \$1500 for a laptop**
- **A Stipend:**
 - \$27,000 for undergraduate students
 - \$32,000 for graduate students
- **EMPLOYMENT** with the DoD: students selected will be required to work for the DoD for one calendar year for each year of scholarship assistance. (NOTE: Students will be required to accept or decline the scholarship within 15 days of notification; relocation may be necessary.)

HOW TO CHECK IF YOU ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY:

The application will consist of two parts. **Part One** determines your eligibility for the DoD CySP program.

Use the link below to create a Cyber Scholarship Account and start applying by completing PART ONE. Once Part One is completed and you are eligible, NU faculty will assist you with Part Two.
