Associate Teacher Certificate (12 units)

The *Associate Teacher Certificate* is designed to be the first step toward obtaining entry-level employment in the field of Early Childhood Education in a preschool or child-care setting.

- The Associate Teacher Certificate requires 12 core Child Development and Education units.
- This Certificate meets *California Title 5* requirements for the Child Development Associate Teacher Permit.
- Applications can be obtained through the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing Website.
- Meets *Title 22* requirements for working in a child care center working with preschool-aged children.
- Additional work experience with young children is currently required to qualify for state permit.

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• In addition to course requirements, several classes require fingerprinting, immunizations, and TB Clearance prior to enrollment.
