## AS Degree in Early Intervention and Inclusion (60 Units) - Or - Certificate in Early Intervention and Inclusion (43 Units)

The **Associate of Science Degree** and **Certificate in Early Intervention and Inclusion (AS-EII)** is designed to prepare students to be trained educators who work with infants to children 8 years of age and who are faced with developmental delays and/or physical disabilities.

- Early intervention provides assistance at the first warning signs of educational difficulty to prevent further impediment.
- Children who receive early intervention services can significantly benefit in lowering the severity of physical, speech, intellectual, and behavioral development issues.
- In addition to course requirements, several classes require fingerprinting, immunizations, and TB Clearance prior to enrollment. Please see notifications following the course outline\*
