Boise State Nursing Program RN-BSN

Plan of Study for students enrolled at Mt. San Jacinto College

All students interested in this RN-BSN program must complete the general education requirements for an associate's degree (Option A) at Mt. San Jacinto College. This plan of study assumes the student is starting their ADN program in the fall semester, therefore would be qualified to start Boise State's program in the spring.

There are three different paths for students interested in this program.

- 1. The first path is for students who would be taking courses concurrently at MSJC and Boise State. Students who wish to take more classes than what are specified by the Department of Nursing at MSJC are advised to meet with an MSJC Nursing Counselor to discuss their course options.
- 2. The second path is for students who only attend Boise State during the summer semester when MSJC Nursing classes are not offered. Students are advised to meet with a Boise State advisor to discuss which courses can be taken during that time frame.
- 3. The third path is for those students who would like to wait and start the program at Boise State after their Nursing degree is completed at MSJC.

Fall semester – Students can apply to Boise State and would be eligible to take classes in the 2nd semester of their ADN program (after completing at least one Nursing class). Dual enrollment is not recommended if the student is still working on their general education classes.
