#### How to Navigate a Job Fair BEFORE YOU BEGIN

- Prepare and proofread your résumé. Plan to bring a large number of résumés on quality paper.
- Dress professional; a suit or business casual is your best choice.
- Write down the questions you would like to ask employers; remember that some employers may not have time to address all of your questions.

#### ATTENDING THE FAIR

- Leave family and friends at home. You need to focus on your career goals.
- Check in at the registration table.
- As you approach an employer's table, respect the privacy of others as they conclude conversations.
- Establish eye contact, smile, introduce yourself and shake hands with the company representative.
- Tell them why you are interested in the organization. Show enthusiasm and interest. Remember, you are the driver of this conversation.
- In one to two sentences, tell the representative about your experience and strengths.
- Be ready to ask your questions AND be ready to answer their questions.
- Ask for business cards from recruiters with whom you have spoken.
- Excuse yourself graciously at the end of the conversation. Don't forget to thank them for their time.

Talk to your doctor if you think you have PTSD Since many common reactions after trauma look like the symptoms of PTSD, a mental health provider must decide if you have PTSD. Providers who have been trained to understand the thoughts and behaviors that go along with PTSD are best able to make that decision.

A provider must use his or her training and judgment to select the best test or set of questions to use. Then he or she must interpret the results of the test.

The American Psychological Association suggests that only trained professionals give tests to assess for PTSD. If you think you may have PTSD, talk to your doctor or a mental health provider. See information on how to find a therapist.
